

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HISTORY OF THE GREENBRIER CLINIC

Our roots in health and wellness run deep—it all began with a small, warm sulphur spring made famous by the distinguished guests who traveled to experience the spring's curative properties.


The Greenbrier developed as a fashionable summer “watering place”—a mineral spring resort—thirty years before the Civil War. Throughout the 19th century it was the great Southern social resort. The Chesapeake and Ohio (C&O) Railway purchased the property in 1910 because everyone traveled to the resort on their trains. They built The Greenbrier hotel in 1913 and The Old White Golf Course in 1914. Then in 1936, Sam Snead, the resort’s longtime golf pro emeritus, began his illustrious career at The Greenbrier.

The resort served as Ashford General Hospital (an Army hospital) during World War II and was comprehensively redecorated by Dorothy Draper shortly after the war. In 1948, The Greenbrier Clinic was established to offer sophisticated diagnostic care in a resort setting. In 1958 The Greenbrier began a partnership with the U.S. Government to provide an emergency relocation center—a bunker—for Congress to be used in case of conflict during the Cold War era. That project ended in 1995 and planning for The Greenbrier Sporting Club, the resort’s private equity club and residential community, began shortly thereafter. The railroad (now the CSX Corporation) sold The Greenbrier to James C. Justice II in May 2009 and he immediately began construction of the casino and created The Greenbrier Classic, a PGA TOUR FedEx Cup golf tournament.

In 2011, The Greenbrier announced the creation of The Greenbrier Medical Institute, which will revolutionize healthcare—establishing a medical mecca with numerous components including wellness, research, product development, education, cosmetic surgery, sports medicine, rehabilitation and other specialties. The initial phase of the medical complex included the completion of the Sports Performance Center in 2014.





AREAS OF SPECIALIZATION

COSMETIC SURGERY	<p>The industry's best practices are brought to patients through the confluence of medical skill and art at The Greenbrier Center for Cosmetic Surgery and MedSpa. Our mission is to restore one's form and function and enhance their physical image. We strive to help individuals achieve a distinct look reflective of their own inner beauty through medically sound procedures including surgeries of the face, breast, and body; cosmetic injectables; and various skin therapy treatments.</p>
CARDIOLOGY	<p>The Clinic's Noninvasive Cardiovascular Imaging Laboratory is fully accredited by the Intersociety Commission for the Accreditation of Vascular and Echocardiographic Laboratories. Services include nuclear stress testing, echocardiography, Doppler echocardiography, stress echocardiography, cardiac calcium scoring, extracranial carotid artery imaging, Holter monitoring, segmental blood pressure studies and ambulatory blood pressure monitoring. These services are supervised and interpreted by our physician staff, under the direction of our board-certified cardiologist.</p>
RADIOLOGY	<p>The Fully Accredited Radiology Department at The Greenbrier Clinic just received all new state-of-the-art equipment consisting of digital radiology, 3D mammography with tomosynthesis, 2 advanced ultrasound machines, and a 128 slice GE CT scanner with capabilities of performing studies such as sinus, head, abdomen, thorax, cardiac calcium score, cardiac angiography, and virtual colonoscopy. The radiology department operates under the supervision of our on-staff, full-time board-certified radiologist.</p>
GASTROENTEROLOGY	<p>Colonoscopy and Upper Endoscopy (evaluation of esophagus, stomach, and upper small intestine) are performed in our Ambulatory Surgical Center for cancer screening purposes and symptom assessment by our board-certified gastroenterologist. In addition, polyps (potentially cancerous intestinal growths) are removed and other therapeutic procedures such as esophageal dilation.</p>
LABORATORY	<p>On-site Full service lab facilities – The Clinic also has a Fully Accredited laboratory. We are proud that our laboratory has been consistently recognized with the COLA award (COLA Accredited laboratories that meet the Laboratory Excellence Award (LEA) have had zero citations on their survey; no unsuccessful Proficiency Testing (PT) for any regulated analyte/subspecialty/specialty for the last two years and had no substantiated complaints for the past two years). In addition, our laboratory reports 98% of all lab studies in house, which means there is little need for a reference lab. Sending to reference labs would slow down the results that our physicians depend on in a timely fashion.</p>



INTERNAL MEDICINE

The Greenbrier Clinic is staffed by a team of internal medicine physicians. An internal medicine physician is specifically trained to evaluate adults. During your physical at The Clinic, a comprehensive hour-long evaluation performed by an internist will include a review of your past medical history, physical examination and current health concerns. Appropriate laboratory evaluation and diagnostic testing is offered on site to include services of our x-ray department, cardiac testing, ambulatory surgery center, laboratory, and nursing services. A nutritional consultation may also be obtained. An exit interview is included on the second day to cover the results of your full examination. A detailed report with a discussion is made available to the patient in writing.

RHEUMATOLOGY

Evaluations for rheumatology, which include diseases affecting the joints, muscles and bones, are routinely performed at The Clinic. X-ray examinations and bone density tests for osteoporosis are also offered. Some of our physicians perform injections for the treatment of inflamed joints and tendons. Specific forms of treatment for osteoporosis such as Prolia and Reclast injections are offered to appropriate candidates.

ENDOCRINOLOGY

Evaluation for disorders of the endocrine system is routinely performed at The Clinic. This may include disorders of thyroid function, menopause, diabetes, low testosterone, osteoporosis and cancers, which involve the endocrine organs. Fine needle aspiration is performed on suspicious thyroid nodules by our endocrinologist. Diabetic teaching can also be performed by one of our highly trained skilled nurses.

ORTHOPAEDICS

The medical specialty that focuses on injuries and diseases of your body's musculoskeletal system. This complex system includes your bones, joints, ligaments, tendons, muscles, and nerves and allows you to move, work, and be active. Dr. Frank Ebert specializes in joint replacements of the hip and knee and commonly sees patients with the following problems: Adult patients with knee and hip arthritis who require total joint replacement, Avascular necrosis, patients with prior knee or hip replacement requiring revision surgery, dislocated total joint prosthesis, and peri-prosthetic fractures.
