Frequently Asked Questions

What is Oakhurst?

Oakhurst, the newest neighborhood planned for The Greenbrier Sporting Club, will offer the opportunity to live alongside a new mountaintop golf course designed by four legends of the game—Jack Nicklaus, Arnold Palmer, Gary Player, and Lee Trevino. 402 homesites and 98 condominiums are proposed. These properties will offer magnificent mountain views overlooking the new golf course, as well as the historic 9-hole golf course, Oakhurst Links. In addition to the new 8,042-yard, 18-hole championship designed golf course, other planned amenities for the Oakhurst neighborhood and for future use by members of The Greenbrier Sporting Club include a well-appointed clubhouse, fitness area, dining, pro shop, outdoor pool, ski and snowboard facilities, fishing, hiking, biking, and more.

In what capacity will the four legends of golf work together?

Golf legends Jack Nicklaus, Arnold Palmer, Gary Player, and Lee Trevino are collaborating for the first time on one golf course—an unprecedented architectural achievement in the history of designing golf courses. Chairman and Owner James C. Justice II has brought together these four golf legends to jointly design this championship course, with the goal of one day hosting a major championship, perhaps even a U.S. Open.

Will the new Oakhurst amenities and activities be open to the public?

No. As the newest neighborhood of The Greenbrier Sporting Club, amenities and activities including the new golf course will not be available for public play. The use of these exclusive recreational facilities require purchase of a membership in The Greenbrier Sporting Club, Inc., the private equity club and residential community within The Greenbrier. Membership also provides access to other private Club amenities and activities, as well as more than 55 activities at The Greenbrier resort.

What is Oakhurst Links?

The existing historic 9-hole Oakhurst Links course—the oldest golf club in America—will be incorporated into this new neighborhood as part of The Greenbrier Sporting Club. Built in 1884 and purchased by The Greenbrier resort in 2012, Oakhurst Links is a 30-acre course, museum, and clubhouse listed on the National Register of Historic Places and located just a few miles north of The Greenbrier. Conventional golf clubs are not used at Oakhurst. Golfers—often dressed in period golf attire—play with hickory-shafted clubs and hit gutta-percha balls off tees fashioned from sand and water, the way it was done more than 130 years ago.

What types of homesites and homes will be available?

402 homesites and 98 condominiums are proposed. Each will encompass something very unique—magnificent mountain views combined with fairway living, and some offering ski-in/ski-out accessibility.*
